

## Alameda High Senior Designs Website to Support Local Restaurants



Alameda High senior, Kyle Wonzen, has designed a searchable website listing all of the City's restaurants that are open for take-out/delivery during the shelter-in-place order. The Alameda Eats website was commissioned by the

Alameda Chamber of Commerce and includes more than 140 eateries located in the City. In addition to encouraging Alamedans to order food online to feed their families, the website also features links for community members to support the City of Alameda's Food Bank and Alameda Meals on Wheels.

"We hope that Kyle's website will encourage Alameda residents to join the 'Great American Takeout Movement," says Madlen Saddick, president and CEO of the Alameda Chamber of Commerce. "Cities across the country are promoting this movement to help restaurants to financially survive this crisis."

Wonzen got his graphic design start in the Career Technical Education multimedia pathway at Alameda High, under the guidance of teacher Andrea Szeto. After doing an internship with the City of Alameda he also designed the City's "AlamedaCounts" website for the census and the "Let's Talk Alameda" website that promotes teen mental health.
