Bay Farm Elementary School

- ART/SPORTS/CAFETERIA: supplies are currently in one room. How will this improve? Where is the best place to store art supplies?
- Can there be a space for Art, music and more to share where the supplies are kept and used in that room? Art storage near stage?
- No art storage. We need art storage for each grade level, and it would be great to have an Art Room.

Earhart Elementary School

- Perimeter fence needed at corner where proposed amphitheater is placed. Very close to street. Garden space priority over track and field.
- In the proposed new classroom pods: Snacks/fridge space for snacks in common part of buildings. Parents provide snacks, but fresh fruit/veggies are rare because they spoil.

Edison Elementary School

• This drop off is unnecessary and a waste of taxpayers money.

- Please try to preserve the trees while building the 2 story kinder/daycare/science/music building.
- Personally, as a taxpayer, I would prefer to see our money go to the benefit of our children and their education than staff building.
- (Expanded multi-use room) This may not be worth the cost for such a small amount of space.

Otis Elementary School

- Where will childcare be located? There are currently 70 children in daycare and the school is expanding, so they will need more space.

Question and Answer Session:

- At Thompson Field will McKinley Park stay? (yes)
- What about the AUSD warehouse? (FMP shows renovation)
- Matching funds legacy? Virtually gone (OPSC). May come back around. If so, HAHS would be eligible for seismic upgrade money
- Modernization funds? Program exists but no state money in it currently
- How many districts are queued ahead of AUSD? A few.
- Will bond pass? Yes.
- What are we asking tax payers? Tax impacts will be discussed at next board meeting.
- Bay Farm Does it get an art supply room? Art rooms are not included in Elem.
 Schools in District Standards.
- Facilities master plan: Demographics: Do they address how many and where etc. i.e. which type of school (elementary/middle/high). Did demographic study do this? Architect's role only focuses on projected enrollment at existing campus.
- Can parts be pulled out and done district wide? Yes.

- Will there be opportunity to re-evaluate as things evolve or have future output? Yes, Programming and design.
- Do we need to have a bond for all of this? Maybe funding from PTA, etc.? Yes, for properly scaled projects.
- Will there be priorities with money attached to each? Yes, developed collectively. By the Board. See May board meetings.
- Is there a Master plan for a single high school? No, but there is information on the construction cost of a new 3,000 student high school.
