

**ALAMEDA CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Board of Education of the Alameda City Unified School District is seeking five (5) qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (BOC) for the implementation of the District's school facilities bond program. The eleven (11) member committee of Alameda residents consists of members representing the following constituencies: Business Representative, Senior Citizen, Taxpayer Organization Member, Parent or Guardian of Child Enrolled in District, Parent or Guardian of Child Enrolled in District & Active in a Parent-Teacher Organization and six (6) At-Large Community Members. Currently the District is looking for the following members:

- 1. Parent or Guardian of Child Enrolled in District & Active in a Parent-Teacher Organization**
- 2. Four (4) At-Large Community members.**

Proposition 39 Bond Election

On November 4, 2014, voters residing within the Alameda City Unified School District passed Measure I. Measure I is a \$179,500,000 bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. On June 7, 2022, voters residing within the Alameda City Unified School District passed Measure B. Measure B is a \$298,000,000 bond measure that authorizes funding for need repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools.

Establishment of a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Alameda City Unified School District Board appoint an Independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to work with the District. On September 13, 2022, the Board approved amended bylaws to allow for one committee to oversee both Measure I and Measure B expenditures.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth; and
- Present to the Board in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of bond proceeds.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Board from applications submitted to the District.

Time Commitment and Term

Committee appointments will be appointed to serve one full two-year term with the option to continue for an additional two terms.
